# From San Francisco International (SFO)

- BART (public transit)
  - 1. Take the Yellow Line (Antioch) BART train directly from SFO BART Station.
  - 2. Ride all the way to **Concord Station**.
    - About 1 hr 15 min, \$12-\$14.
- Shuttle / Rideshare / Taxi
  - o Around 45–60 min drive (without heavy traffic).
  - Uber/Lyft: \$70-\$100+.

# From Oakland International (OAK)

- BART
  - 1. Take the Oakland Airport BART Connector to Coliseum Station.
  - 2. Transfer to the Yellow Line (Antioch) toward Concord.
  - 3. Ride to **Concord Station**.
    - About 1 hr 15 min, \$11-\$13.
- Shuttle / Rideshare / Taxi
  - Around 40–55 min drive.
  - Uber/Lyft: \$60-\$90+.

# From San Jose International (SJC)

- Transit (longer option)
  - 1. VTA Light Rail or shuttle to **Diridon Station**.
  - 2. Take Caltrain to Millbrae.
  - 3. Transfer to BART Yellow Line (Antioch) to Concord.
    - About 2.5–3 hrs, \$15–\$20.
- Shuttle / Rideshare / Taxi

- Around 1 hr 15 min to 1 hr 45 min drive.
- Uber/Lyft: \$90-\$140+.

## Best balance of cost & time:

- From SFO or OAK → BART Yellow Line directly to Concord.
- From SJC → driving/rideshare is usually much faster than transit.

#### SFO → Concord

- Fastest: Rideshare/taxi (≈45–75 min depending on traffic).
- Cheapest (and solid overall): BART Yellow Line (Antioch) directly from SFO → Concord.
  ~1 hr 10–20 min. You can now tap in with a contactless credit/debit card or mobile wallet—no Clipper required. Fare is roughly low-teens.

## OAK → Concord

- Fastest: Rideshare/taxi (≈40–60 min).
- Cheapest (and easy): BART to OAK people-mover (≈9 min) to Coliseum, then Yellow Line (Antioch) → Concord. Typical travel time ~1 hr 10–20 min; fare roughly low-teens.

#### SJC → Concord

- Fastest: Rideshare/taxi (≈1 hr 15–1 hr 45).
- Cheapest (transit): VTA Route 60 from SJC → Milpitas BART (about every 20 min; ~\$3), then BART (Milpitas → transfer at MacArthur → Yellow Line → Concord). Total ~2–2.5 hrs; total fare typically around low-to-mid teens.
- Alternate transit (usually longer & pricier): Caltrain SJC area → Millbrae, transfer to BART Yellow Line → Concord. Useful if you're already near Caltrain; fares add up.

# **Tips**

On BART, you can Tap-and-Ride with a contactless card/phone; discounts (youth/low-income/senior) still require Clipper.

For exact fares for your time of day, use BART's Fare Calculator / Trip Planner (they'll reflect recent fare adjustments).

Here's how to get from **Concord Plaza Hotel** (approximately at or near Concord BART station) to **Clayton Valley Bowl** at **5300 Clayton Road, Concord, CA 94521** via local transit:

Public Transit Option: County Connection — Route 10

#### **Route Overview**

- Take County Connection Route 10 ("BART Concord / Clayton")
  - Leaves from Concord BART about every 15–30 minutes on weekdays (service runs roughly between 5:00 AM and 10:00 PM).
  - Approximate one-way fare: \$2-\$3, with a ride taking around 23 minutes to downtown Clayton.

# **Closest Stop to Clayton Valley Bowl**

- Ride the bus toward Clayton Road, and get off at a stop that's closest to the bowling alley. Based on maps:
  - Clayton Rd and Terry Lynn Ln is about a 5-minute walk from Clayton Valley Bowl
- Total travel time (including walk): ~30 minutes.

• Route coverage: County Connection serves communities like Concord, Clayton, Pleasant Hill, Martinez, Walnut Creek, and more—Route 10 being one of its main lines toward Clayton.
