Hello Bowlers,

We, the Executive Board, are excited and rolling up our sleeves getting ready for our 79th Annual Pacific Coast Deaf Bowling Association, 59th Annual Connie Marchione Masters and 32nd Annual Don I. Miller Senior Masters, and 73rd Annual Pacific Coast Deaf Women's Bowling Association, 55th Annual Jean Stokesbary's Queens, and 25th Annual Lucy Beare's Senior Queens tournament at Steve Cook's Fireside Lanes in Citrus Heights, California on May 27th to 29th, 2022, which will be hosted by PCDBA-PCDWBA.

PCDBA has 10 teams, 40 Singles, 20 Doubles, 25 Masters and 10 Senior Masters competing for the championship.

PCDWBA has 8 teams, 32 Singles, 16 Doubles, 6 Queens and 11 Senior Queens competing for the championship.

So far, we only have six women interested in bowling the Queens event. We need at least two (2) more women to participate to keep the Queens event open. If anyone is interested in participating, please see Tournament Director Bert Enos to sign up any time up to the General Meeting on Friday evening.

Tournament Director Bert Enos is in the process of making some new proposals regarding the Men and Women's Tournament rules. He is of the opinion that the tournament rules should be the same for both associations. There are a few differences in the procedures that don't make sense to keep. Executive Board members Becca Gleicher, Tim Estes and Wendy Spanton also agree, and we look forward to a healthy discussion with you, our members, during the General Meeting. Vice President Tim Estes will be bringing you all up to date on the motions that were made in 2019 at Victorville as well as other by-laws and procedures information.

Friendly Reminder – Tournament Dress Code

For Men:

Shirts with collars or PBA bowling shirt, clean and casual slacks, or shorts. No jeans or cargo pants allowed. Worn out pants, sleeveless shirts, tank tops, collarless shirts, T-shirts, Jogging pants, walking, cutoffs or by any other name, are not permissible. Caps, hats, or headbands are not acceptable unless medical necessity or with permission from tournament officials. PCDBA officers have the right to make decisions they see fit.

For Women:

Bowlers shall wear casual pants, shorts (just above the knee), or skirts and sleeveless Polo with collars. No worn-out jeans/pants, cut-offs, short shorts, sweat suits, spandex leggings, sleeveless t-shirts, and tank tops shall be permitted. Shirt without collar is permitted only if they do not look like T-shirts. Bermuda/walking shorts are permitted.
