### **PCDBA/PCDBWA President & Vice-President's Message:**

Wow! It was fantastic to have seen/met all of you at the tournament in Citrus Heights. After a two-year hiatus due to the covid pandemic, it was certainly awesome to bowl again in a tournament setting!

Many thanks to the volunteers who helped us during the tournament. It was much appreciated!

Congratulations to all the first-place winners and runner ups!

To recap, during our general meeting, we did have two bids for 2027 between Colorado

and Arizona and it was agreed that Colorado would host in 2027 and Arizona would go ahead and host in 2028. We don't want to stop the bidding there, please do keep your mind open for hosting our tournament in 2029 and 2030. The reason for this is that we will not have a general meeting in San Diego during PCDWBA's 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary tournament in 2024 AND then the following year, we will be in Hawaii. Again, there will be no general meeting in 2024, which means we won't be able to vote for 2029 in San Diego and 2030 in Hawaii. We, the Executive Board, really would like to have other clubs make a bid so that you all have time to fundraise for your tournament. Your club will have an extra year or two to your benefit, otherwise if we wait until 2026 to make bids, your clubs will only have three and four years to plan a tournament. Let's stay ahead of the game! Come to Portland ready with a bid and \$500 check for bond to confirm immediately.

The following motions were passed during the general meeting:

1. Removing the complimentary fee for Masters Champ.
2. No re-election until 2026, keeping all four officers intact.
3. Tournament Director gets full salary instead of Secretary-Treasurer.
4. Injured bowlers will not get a refund of membership fee.
5. Women with no average shall be given 150 average.

6. Reversal of Jose Sermeno's 2019 motion to increase prize money from 50% to 75% due to a ratio not figured out right.
7. Approved projector purchase.

I would like to thank the members of PCDBA-PCDWBA for approving the purchase of the projector. It came in handy with the YouTube video of the Pledge of Allegiance, the meeting agenda, and the Hall of Fame announcements.

Looking forward to bowling in Portland next year! We hope that we will have more bowlers joining us next year in Portland. We'd like to see more than just 8 women's and 10 men's teams.

PCDWBA is currently looking into bowling centers and hotels for the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary coming up in 2024 in beautiful San Diego. Right now, there's a teaser flyer up on our website. We will update the information as soon as we get confirmation with the bowling center and hotel.
