Welcome back to bowling - FINALLY!
First of all, I want to say Happy
Holidays. I would like to share with all of
you bowlers about new rules. Bowling balls
may not have extra holes or balance holes.

Bowlers who identify as trans or non-binary must have already applied for a USBC card in their preferred gender. For singles and doubles events, we will bowl on the same pair of lanes for a total of 6 games.

This year we merged entry forms so there is only one form for both women and men. Be sure to send the entry form directly to me. Some of you have not bowled in the last 1-2 years due to Covid 19. You will be able to use your 2019-2020 average. If you did not bowl in 2019, I will check your previous tournament average in PCDBA and PCDWBA. You do NOT need to make a copy of your USBC card because I will check Bowl.com for your current membership. Be sure to write down your USBC membership number CLEARLY on the entry form. Bowlers will still need to have their league secretary to sign the form for league average and number of games bowled by February 1st. If you have any questions, please feel free to email me.
