PCDBA PCDBWA Executive Board's Message:

Happy New Year! Wishing everyone a healthy and prosperous year ahead. May your strikes be strong, your spares be easy, and maybe even a 300 game in your future!

And off to Concord we go....

We are truly looking forward to the **83rd Men's Tournament and the 77th Women's Tournament in Concord, CA this June**. It's great news that SFDC found a new bowling center. Clayton Valley Bowl, the location change is a positive one — it's much closer to the airports for those flying in and more convenient for anyone wanting to explore San Francisco or Berkeley. SFDC has offered a guaranteed prize fund of \$5,000.

New Rules and Information

- ❖ We will no longer award the Senior Women All Events award. All bowlers will be required to pay for All-Events.
- ❖ Senior Masters and Senior Queens will now bowl scratch, one game double elimination based on all-event scratch scores for qualifying.
- ❖ If a team has no bowler, they can use VACANT with 140 average. If VACANT wins money, money goes into the general fund.
- ❖ If a bowler is absent from an event, will get -30 from their average for each game.
- ❖ The Queens' 189 average limit has been lifted.
- ❖ Bowlers who have no established tournament or league average will be assigned a 200 average.
- ❖ Senior Queens is now 169 average and under, Senior Masters is 189 average and under.

Future Tournament Bids

We are also seeking clubs to bid for hosting the **2029, 2030, and 2031 tournaments**. We can't rely on the same clubs to host year after year, as it places a financial strain on them.

Clubs need time to rebuild their tournament funds, and we truly need others to step up and take on this important role so that PCDBA PCDWBA can continue to stay strong for you all.

Motions

Please send in your motions to Vice-President Tim Estes by May 10th. Motions may be brought on the floor but may not be accepted depending on what type. If it is bylaw related, then we ask that you send that by May 10th.

New Entry Form

Following last year's general meeting motion that was passed, we worked on developing a new web-based entry form using the **Jotform** platform, and it's ready to go!

We will also be accepting digital payments like Zelle and PayPal. It is 2026, and it's time we continue growing with today's technology. The entry form link can be found at the end of this newsletter.

For bowlers requesting refunds after paying entry forms, we will need medical documentation and you will be refunded all but the \$12 membership fee.

Notes from Tournament Director Enos

I would like to explain our new online entry form. Each bowler MUST fill out the entry form individually. ONLY the team captain should enter the bowling order (#1–#4), which determines who bowls first. Please be sure to type your USBC number very carefully.

The captain must ask their team members who will bowl first and second for the Doubles event. Please do NOT enter the lineup if you are not the captain. I will only follow the captain's submitted lineup.

For bowlers who need a pick-up bowler, you may choose "yes" under Need pick-up bowler on page 3 of entry form.

There are many changes to the tournament rules for both men and women. Please be patient with me—I will be making a video and posting it on our website and on the PCDBA / PCDWBA Facebook pages. Most of the rule changes will relate to Seniors for both men and women.

For NEW bowlers only, you will need your league secretary's signature and must complete an average verification form.

Looking forward to bowling with all of you in Concord. We can't wait to see everyone in June!
